Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in
FIR No.42 dated 13.08.2010 registered under Sections
379/411/420/465/468/471/201 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station SGN
Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda.

It is undisputed that co-accused of the petitioner has been
acquitted after trial. However, since, petitioner was declared a proclaimed
offender, therefore, he could not be tried with other co-accused. Petitioner was
arrested on 16.03.2019. He is in custody since then. Investigation against the
petitioner is complete and challan has already been presented.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and without commenting on
the merits of the case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his
furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial
Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
