Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.121 dated 10.07.2018 under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 13 of the Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, contended that the petitioners have already joined the investigation and are not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 27.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
