In the present writ petition, the first claim which is being made by the petitioner is that similarly situated personnel as the petitioner, have been granted the benefit of three additional increments on account of possessing higher qualification in terms of a Circular dated 23.07.1957 and the second claim is for the grant of proficiency step up, which benefit was allowed by this Court while deciding CWP No. 16095 of 2012 and other connected cases, decided on 16.05.2016 (Annexure P-8).

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the benefit of the said judgment is not being given to the petitioner and she is being forced to file the present writ petition claiming the same relief as already extended to the similarly situated employees.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served

the respondents with a legal notice dated 05.03.2019 (Annexure P-9) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 05.03.2019 (Annexure P-9) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioners are found entitled for any benefit, the arrears will be restricted from the date of filing of the present writ petition. No arrears will be paid till the filing of the present writ petition.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
