Instant writ petition was directed against the charge-sheet dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-8) as also the statement of charges formulated at Annexure P-9.

The precise article of charge that had been formulated against the petitioner was of being willfully absent from duty for the period 02.02.2000 to 17.07.2000.

Counsel representing the petitioner makes a statement that after filing of the instant writ petition, there has been a subsequent development inasmuch as the competent authorities have taken a decision to regularise the afore-noticed period and which formed the very basis of issuance of the charge sheet.
