Short reply has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, in Court today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

[1] Learned counsel for the petitioners on instructions from petitioner No.2, who is present in Court states that he does not wish to press the writ petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[2] Prayer on behalf of petitioner No.2 is not opposed by counsel for the respondents. Accordingly, writ petition *qua* petitioner No.2 is ***dismissed as withdrawn.***

[3] Learned counsel for petitioner No.1 states that petitioner No.1 also does not press the writ petition and would be satisfied, if directions are issued to the respondent-University to arrange extra classes for him for the 3rd semester to enable him to appear in the examination for the 3rd semester

scheduled to be held in the month of December, 2019 and in the meantime, he

be allowed to avail all facilities, including hostel facilities as a student of the respondent-University.

[4] Learned counsel for the respondent-University on instructions from Dr. Phool Singh, Associate Professor of the respondent-University states that the respondent-University would arrange classes of the 3rd semester for petitioner No.1 to enable him to complete the attendance requirements in terms of Ordinance XXIX, so as to appear in the examination for the 3rd semester scheduled to be held in the month of December, 2019, besides petitioner would be permitted to avail all facilities as are admissible to a student of the respondent-University.

[5] The same satisfies learned counsel for petitioner No.1.

[6] Writ petition ***disposed of*** as above.
