Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.128 dated 25.03.2019 under Sections 409, 420, 120-B IPC and Sections 7 & 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal.

Vide order dated 24.05.2019, notice of motion was issued and the petitioner was granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail, by passing the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the order dated 10.05.2019 wherein the similarly situated co-accused has been granted the anticipatory bail.....”

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance

of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Chander Bhan, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.05.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
