GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory in a case registered against him vide FIR No.167 dated 5.3.2019 under Sections 323, 365, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Bhiwani Sadar, District Bhiwani.
2. I find that the petitioner had earlier approached the trial Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail which was dismissed as withdrawn. Although at the time of withdrawing the petition, the learned counsel for the petitioner did not reserve his right to approach the Court again, but having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and also that the co-accused has been

granted anticipatory bail, the petitioner is granted liberty to approach trial Court again seeking grant of anticipatory bail especially since his earlier petition for grant of anticipatory was never dealt with on merits by the Court of Sessions.

3. The petition is disposed of as such.
