The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for directing the respondents not to cancel the allotment of land to the petitioner to install the verka booth under DMW Flyover allotted vide letter No. 5794 dated 19.3.2019 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the land in question was allotted to the petitioner for installation of verka milk booth on rent basis after examining the issue that it does not create any obstacle in the free movement of the traffic. Now on account of political pressure, without issuing any notice, respondent No.4 proposes to demolish the booth installed by the petitioner.

At the asking of the Court, Ms.Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab

accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete set of paper book has been supplied to her.

Considering the fact that the booth in question was installed after due permission vide letter No.19.3.2019 (Annexure P-5) issued by the competent authority and without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that before initiating any demolition process, the petitioner be issued clear 15 days notice and also provided opportunity of personal hearing to him.
