This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.49 dated 05.04.2019 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149 and 307 IPC at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh.

As per the allegations, somebody told the complainant that some boys were beating her son. When she went there, Sahil, Rishabh and some other boys mercilessly beating her son.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that there is only one injury on the head to which Section 307 IPC has been attributed. Further he has argued that Sahil and Rishabh are in custody and the petitioner was not named and he has now been in custody for the past 50 days.

Learned Public Prosecutor on instructions from S.I. Ashwani

Kumar states that one more case is pending against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned C.J.M/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
