The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.235, dated 7.10.2015, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar City.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the alleged recovery is 250 grams of intoxicant powder and the commercial quantity starts from more than 250 grams. The petitioner was released on interim bail on 20.11.2015 and ever since no other case is pending against him.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has been in custody for 1 month and 29 days. Learned DAG Punjab has accepted that no other case is pending against the petitioner.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the

petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
