This criminal revision has been filed by the petitioner to challenge the order dated 20.07.2013 passed by the trial Court whereby the application for declaring the petitioner as juvenile was declined.

Learned Senior counsel does not dispute the fact that the petitioner is still a proclaimed offender as he is not appearing before the trial Court. He further contends that the trial in respect of the other co-accused persons is complete, who have been acquitted.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, who has willfully and deliberately absented from the trial proceedings, this Court is not inclined to entertain this petition.

Resultantly, this petition is dismissed.
