Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tirath Ram Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar Rural submits that in consequence of interim order dated 24.06.2019 passed by the Supreme Court in Special Leave to Appeal No.5327 of 2019, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.06.2019 is made absolute till submission of report

under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
