The petitioners have earlier approached this Court by way of writ petition bearing CWP No. 6903 of 2019 which was disposed vide order dated 14.03.2019 with the following order:-

“Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to decide the representation dated 15.12.2018 (Annexure P-3).

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the bank by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation by giving the time schedule for clearing the outstanding liability alongwith payment of reasonable outstanding amount.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners has conceded that after passing of the aforesaid order no representation has been made by the

petitioners to the respondent-Bank. He has, thus, prayed for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to approach the respondent-Bank again.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty granted.
