Counsel at the very outset makes a statement at the bar that he is not pressing the instant petition for petitioner No.2.

Accordingly, the instant petition survives only qua petitioner No.1

Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect her life and liberty by voicing an apprehension that she faces a threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 and 5.

Counsel submits that petitioner was married to respondent No.4 in the year 2015. A male child was born out of wedlock and who is presently in the custody of the father/respondent No.4.

It has been asserted that the petitioner has been harassed at the hands of her husband as also mother-in-law and that the petitioner was turned out of the matrimonial home on 12.05.2019 and she is now staying with her parents.

Counsel contends that the petitioner has received threatening calls from her husband and which has necessitated filing of the instant writ petition.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner and having perused the pleadings on record and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.3 i.e. SHO Police Station Kundli, District Sonapat as regard the threat perception that she has voiced against respondents No.4 and 5.

In the eventuality of any such application/representation being made by the petitioner, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to take steps thereafter as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
