This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No. 3 to initiate criminal proceedings as per application (Annexure P-1).

Initially, the petitioner married with Sukhwinder Masih. She had not obtained divorce. Now she produced an affidavit sworn by Sukhwinder Masih which transpires that both had been residing separately but to the mind of this Court, her marriage with Sukhwinder Masih has not been dissolved and it still subsists. Contrary to it, she has shown her status in this petition as wife of Jagtar.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to State of Punjab to verify as to whether the petitioner has obtained divorce from her previous husband-Sukhwinder Masih or she married with Jagtar and consider and decide her application (Annexure P-1) with a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
