ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.177 dated 18.04.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, and 324 IPC, registered at Police Station Shahabad (M), District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is outcome of a sudden fight and the injuries which have been sustained by the complainant and another person are simple in nature. He also contends that the offence under Section 324 IPC is bailable.

This Court, by the order dated 22.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Devinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 22.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
