Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 6 to enquire into any complaint received by them within their jurisdiction against the petitioners under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code and in case of registration of any FIR they be given 15 days advance notice before their arrest.

On instructions from the police official who is present in the Court, learned State counsel has apprised the Court that petitioners are facing number of criminal cases and reference is made to paragraph 11 and 15 of the affidavit of Sh. Gurpreet Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West) Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for respondent No.7 has also apprised the Court that one more criminal case bearing FIR No. 0406 dated 18.12.2018, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code has been registered at Police Station Division 5, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana against the petitioner No. 1-Baldev Singh and petitioner No.2-Malkit Kaur.

On the last date of hearing, none appeared in this case. Today, also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. It seems that petitioners are not interested in pursuing the present petition, therefore, the same is dismissed for non-prosecution.
