On 21.05.2019, following order was passed:-

“The petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 and 5. They have placed on record photographs Annexures P-4 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 19.05.2019, Annexure P-5 to respondent no.2.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent no.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim

protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 31.05.2019.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Rajinder Singh, SI has submitted that the petitioners as well as respondent no.4, who is mother of petitioner no.1 have made a statement to the effect that the petitioners now do not have any apprehension to their life and liberty and respondent no.4 has made a statement that she has accepted the marriage between the petitioners and undertaken not to interfere in their matrimonial life.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is not disputing the correctness of the aforesaid statement.

In view thereof, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
