AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 29.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.11606 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“With the consent of parties, main case is taken up hearing today itself. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he shall be satisfied in case a decision is taken on the representation, Annexure P-3 within a fixed time frame. Learned State counsel submits that in case aforesaid representation has been received in the office of the concerned authority, same shall be considered and a speaking order shall passed thereon within two months. In view of above, petition is hereby disposed of.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Udaydeep Singh, PCS, Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Bathinda has been filed today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. Alongwith the reply, order dated 12.09.2019 has been annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of reply filed no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against order dated 12.09.2019.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
