The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in FIR No.88, dated 11.07.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC (offence under Section 307 IPC stands deleted and offence under Section 326 IPC added), registered at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 19.11.2018, petitioners have joined the investigation and have been cooperating therewith. This is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State.
