ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.225 dated 12.08.2017, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 365, 307, 120-B and 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had allegedly hit on the head of Gautam with a pipe. However, this injury was found to be simple in nature.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 22.11.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial

interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 22.11.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
