Petitioner Ashish has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.25 dated 17.02.2019, registered at Police Station Pillukhera, District Jind, under Sections 398/401 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR in the present case has been registered on the basis of secret information and on conducting the raid, the present petitioner along with I-20 car and .315 bore pistol was apprehended on the spot.

The petitioner has been in custody since 17.02.2019. He is not

required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
