ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.157 dated 10.10.2018, under Sections 420, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he had taken money for sending the daughter of the complainant to Canada. He also contends that the petitioner has already paid a sum of Rs.1.5 lakhs to the complainant as he wants to settle the dispute and he shall pay another sum of Rs.1,70,000/- within two months from today. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad-idem that the matter is being compromised and they will work out the modalities of the compromise including the outstanding amount to be paid by the petitioner.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 21.11.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 21.11.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
