Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0151 dated 22.08.2018 (P-4), under Sections 452, 323, 324, 325, 506, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 20.11.2018, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that the alleged occurrence is of 19.08.2018 and FIR no. 151 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 325, 506, 148, 149 and 326 (added later on) IPC was registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar on 22.08.2018. Further contends that from the petitioner side also there is a cross version i.e. private complaint under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Annexure P-2) filed before SDJM, Baba Bakala Sahib, District Amritsar, in which the allegations are that father of the petitioner has suffered the injuries.

Notice of motion for 28.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, Head Constable Jagir Singh, Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural submits that both the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of order dated 20.11.2018 and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, interim order dated 20.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioners shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
