[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has filed a complaint (Annexure P-2) dated 17.04.2017 with regard to over-charging of fees by respondent No.3 with the Chairperson, Regulatory Authority constituted under the *Punjab Regulation of Fee of Unaided Educational Institution Act, 2016* but till date, no decision has been taken in respect thereto. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law.

[2] In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
