Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.179 dated 25.06.2018 under Sections 370, 384, 389, 342, 120-B, 376, 354-C IPC, Section 4 of the POCSO Act, 2012 and Section 67 of the Information & Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Gurtej S. Sidhu, submits that out of total 25 witnesses as cited by the prosecution, all the witnesses have been examined except Inspector Vinod Kumar, whose examination-in-chief is complete and now the case is fixed for cross-examination of this witness today itself.
