Col. Bhupinder Singh Shergill, retired, who claims to be the attorney/representative as he happens to be the maternal grand-father of petitioner Prithvi Singh Mangat and his sister Amandeep Kaur (also referred as Prithvi Singh and Amandeep Kaur Mangat) has appeared and identified by counsel Shri Baljinder Singh.

Without further delaying the disbursement of the amount due, the demand drafts bearing No.757462 and 757463 dated 23.04.2019 drawn on State Bank of India for an amount of Rs.1,25,000/- each favouring Prithvi Singh Mangat and Amandeep Kaur are ordered to be handed over to Col. Bhupinder Singh Shergill

against proper receipt and identification with undertaking that he will deposit the amount in the accounts of the above said petitioners.

Since the undertaking given by the two sides as is reflective from the pervious order of this Court 25.09.2018 stands fulfilled and, thus, Col. Bhupinder Singh Shergill as well as his counsel Mr. Baljinder Singh have submitted that they are fully satisfied on this compliance and, therefore, do not purse the present petition and wish to withdraw the same.

Allowed to do so.
