1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although FIR No.54 dated 13.6.2013 under Section 3(1)(10) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Raja Sansi, Amritsar was registered at the instance of complainant way back in the year 2013 but till date no effective investigation has been conducted in the matter and none of the accused have ever been arrested.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and to ensure that the matter pertaining to FIR No.54 dated

13.6.2013 under Section 3(1)(10) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Raja Sansi, Amritsar is got investigated expeditiously so that a final report be filed thereupon at the earliest.
