Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press upon his petition at this stage and that some direction be issued to the trial Court for expediting the trial.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn being not pressed at this stage.

Since the prosecution has been able to partly examine only one PW out of cited 17 PWs despite the fact that the petitioner has been

behind bars since last 1 ½ years, the prosecution is directed to make strenuous efforts for conclusion of the trial expeditiously. The prosecution is directed to ensure the presence of the PWs on the date fixed before the trial Court.
