The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.41 dated 08.05.2019, under Sections 324, 325 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner and she is alleged to have instigated the other accused who have caused injuries to the injured.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 29.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish Chander, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 29.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
