This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 21.5.2018 passed in CWP No. 12786 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

*"3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their respective representations dated 13.01.2018 (P-2 to P-4) and to decide the same in accordance with law especially in the light of the decision of the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in LPA No. 352 of 2014, decided on 31.08.2016 in the case of **State of Punjab and others vs. A.P. Sharma and others** (P-1), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the authority comes to the conclusion that petitioners are entitled to the relief claimed through the instant petition, to calculate and release the same within next 45 days.*

4. However, in case petitioners are still aggrieved by any of the order passed by the afore-said authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse the other remedies available to them under law including to approach this Court."

Learned State counsel has produced four orders today and same are taken on record. Copy supplied to counsel for petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that claim of the petitioners in the representation has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the orders passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
