Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 23.03.2018 passed by the trial Court, in FIR No.35 dated 19.03.2014 under Sections 323, 325, 35 IPC, Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar City, vide which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 23.05.2019, petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court, he is released on interim bail and is facing the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Singh, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.05.2019 is made absolute and the order dated 23.03.2018 passed by the trial Court, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender, is set aside.
