Vide this order, CRM-M-23641 of 2019 and CRM-M-24903 of 2019 shall stand disposed of.

Prayer in both the petitions is to grant regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.582 dated 08.12.2018 registered under Sections 380, 457, 411 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Urban Estate Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the

investigations are complete and challan has been presented.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the investigating agency could not verify as to whether petitioner-Aashik is visible in any of the CCTV footage of various ATM machines or not. The case is triable by the Magistrate. The petitioner-Ram Chander @ Ramu is in custody since 30.01.2019 and the petitioner-Aashik is in custody since 09.01.2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail (in both petitions) subject to furnishing of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed.
