Petitioners-Deepak, Pardeep and Sandeep have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.143 dated 11.04.2019, registered at Police Station Gannaur, District Sonipat, under Sections 323, 506 and 34 of the IPC and Section 308 of the IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that petitioner No.1-Deepak is stated to be armed with an iron rod, petitioner No.2-Pardeep is stated to be armed with a bottle and petitioner No.3-Sandeep is stated to be armed with a brick. They have given injuries on the head of the injured, which have been declared as simple. No injury has been declared dangerous to life.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
