This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0029 dated 19.01.2019, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 of the IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered on the complaint given by one Janko Devi with the allegations that her husband is running a shop and he had an altercation with one Ramna, who is residing opposite to their house. On 18.01.2019, said Ramna along with the petitioner started abusing the husband of the complainant and thereafter, they caused injuries to him with the help of iron rod.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.04.2019 and he is not involved in

any other case and subsequent to the registration of the FIR, a compromise has been effected between the petitioner and the husband of the complainant, namely Jasbir Singh.

Learned counsel for the complainant has acknowledge the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of the custody certificate filed today in Court, has not disputed the factual position. As per custody certificate, the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.04.2019; the trial is likely to take some time to conclude and also in view of the fact that petitioner is not involved in any other case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
