This application is for placing on record copy of zimni orders passed by the trial Court.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the zimni orders annexed as Annexure A-1 (Colly.) with the application are taken on record.

MAIN CASE

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.120 dated 08.10.2017, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 452, 107, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 452 IPC was deleted and offence under Sections 325/326 IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was found innocent in the investigation but he has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. as an additional accused. He also contends that the co-accused

namely Suman and Sarabjit, who were also summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C., have been released on anticipatory bail. It is a case of version and cross version and it is yet to be decided by the trial Court that as to which of the party was the initial aggressor. There is a delay of two days in lodging the FIR as well.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 26.11.2018, had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court and has referred to the order of the trial Court dated 03.12.2018 (Annexure A-1 Colly.) granting him interim bail. He also contends that the petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial Court.

In view of the above, interim order dated 26.11.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall appear regularly before the trial Court and shall not absent himself without the prior permission of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of.
