GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.85, dated 16.9.2017, registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on).
2. The FIR in question had initially been registered in the year September 2017 for offences under Section 323 and 324 IPC wherein the petitioner had been released on bail.
3. However, subsequently on 23.5.2018, the police had added an offence under Section 307 IPC after having obtained an opinion of the Doctor.

4. Pursuant to directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation as has been informed by learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sawtantarpal Singh.
5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and also that ever since the petitioner was granted bail initially in September 2017, petitioner has not misused the concession of bail and have joined the investigation, the petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 22.11.2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
