This order shall dispose of two contempt petitions.

Learned counsel for the parties are, *ad idem*, that the possession

of the official house has been handed over by Sh. Prem Singh to Bhakra

Beas Management Board (BBMB). With regard to non-charging of penal rent for the period when the operation of termination order was stayed, the calculation has been handed over by the learned counsel for the BBMB, as per calculations, there is a refund of Rs. 1,76,788/- of penal rent.

Learned counsel for the BBMB submits that the refund would be issued within two weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the parties agree that both the contempt petitions have been rendered infructuous. However, learned counsel for the petitioner-Prem Singh seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law, if aggrieved of the calculations of the rent.

Both the contempt petitions are disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against respondents is discharged.
