The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 20.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 37768 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondents to consider the case of the petitioner, keeping in view judgment dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-12) and pass appropriate orders on the notice/representation dated 05.12.2018 (P-13), in accordance with law.”

A short reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Virender Kumar Dahiya, IAS, Director State Transport, Haryana, Chandigarh has been filed today in Court and the same is taken on record. Along with reply, order dated 29.08.2019 has been annexed. A copy is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner has been rejected, there is no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against order dated 29.08.2019.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
