The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.108, dated 19.3.2016, registered under Sections 302, 201, 364 of the IPC, at Police Station City Bahadurgar, District Jhajjar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has now been in custody for 2 years, 6 months and 24 days and that 15 witnesses are yet to be examined.

On the last date, it was mentioned that there was another case pending at Delhi. Today, learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, states that no other case is pending against the petitioner. He has also accepted that 15 witnesses are yet to be examined.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of

the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to conclude in the near future, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
