Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0112 dated 17.10.2018 under Sections 376, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot.

Pursuant to the order dated September 25, 2019, petitioner is present in person.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Som Dutt, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and even the investigation is over. Challan has been presented and in this manner, the case is now fixed for framing of charge before the trial Court.

This Court had already passed the order dated July 09, 2019.

However, before the order could be signed, the complainant has put in appearance and submitted that the said case has not come to her notice that this Court has adjourned the case for 11.07.2019.

Considering the fact that challan in the case has been presented and the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required by the prosecution, the present petition for anticipatory bail is rendered infructuous.
