“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that this petition may kindly be allowed and direction be issued to respondent no.2 and 3 to register FIR against respondent no.4 & 5 under section 302/34 of IPC and conduct proper, fair and impartial investigation into the case.

And/or

With further prayer for issuance of direction to the respondent no.2 to decide the representation/application dated 16.10.2017 i.e. Annexure P-2, within stipulated time.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Bhupinder Singh, has submitted that the report from the Chemical

Examiner, Forensic Science Laboratory, has been received and no poison was found. Hence, he submits that the police after investigation has already filed report under Section 174 Cr.P.C.
