The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 13.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 24324 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 24.6.2018 (Annexure P-8), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 24.6.2018 (Annexure P-8) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter.”

Short reply dated 26.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Sh. Subash Chander, District Education Officer (SE), Sangrur filed in court is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the pleadings in the reply, amount of ₹90,000/- has been paid to the petitioner vide cheque No. 625115 dated 11.3.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits the said fact but states that there is a grievance with regard to rate of interest. He seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
