1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair investigation in the matter pertaining to FIR No.22 dated 9.2.2018 under Sections 295, 341, 506, 323/34 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station City Moga, District Moga.
2. Learned counsel has submitted that although the FIR in question was lodged more than a year back but no effective investigation has been conducted in the matter and in fact none of the accused has been arrested so far. It has also been submitted that he had made a representation dated 4.2.2019 to Senior Superintendent of Police,

Moga, but even said representation has remained undecided.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-2) expeditiously in accordance with law and to ensure that the matter pertaining to FIR No.22 dated 9.2.2018 under Sections 295, 341, 506, 323/34 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station City Moga, District Moga is got investigated expeditiously so that a final report is filed thereafter at the earliest.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
