This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to close the drainage (Nala) dugged in front of the house of the petitioners due to party faction in the village.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 - Deputy Commissioner, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 10.4.2019 (Annexure P-2 ) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Ms.Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3

- Deputy Commissioner, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 10.4.2019 (Annexure P-2 ) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
