Report dated 12.06.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Ludhiana has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioner Anubhav Chopra and the complainant Anshula Chaudhary as well as respondents No. 3 and 4, namely, Anil chopra and Anita Chopra, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the

fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 39 dated 09.04.2018 registered at Police Station Women, Ludhiana under Sections 498-A, 406, 417 and 420 IPC all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner as well as against respondents No. 3 and 4 are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
