Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.50 dated 07.09.2018 under Sections 307, 452, 324, 323, 506, 336, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurjant Singh, contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 22.11.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
