This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 144 dated 23.04.2019, registered under Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9 of the Immoral Traffic Act, 1956 at Police Station DLF, Phase-I, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are in judicial custody since 24.04.2019 and the investigation is almost complete and they are not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioner No. 1 is having a minor child and there is nobody to look after the child. It is further submitted that conclusion of the trial is likely to take a long time.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificates and has not disputed the fact that the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioners are in judicial custody since 24.04.2019; they are not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioners Annadas @ Pooja and Gaichamei Rongmei @ Jaini are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
