The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.2 has performed marriage with petitioner No.1 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Grewal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record affidavit of landlord of the petitioners alongwith ID. The same is taken on record. He further submitted that a representation dated 20.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) was made to the Superintendent of Police, Panchkula seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Panchkula to look into the grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.

The Superintendent of Police, Panchkula is further directed to arrange a meeting of respondent No. 4 with petitioner No.2 in case any such application is moved.

It is made clear that in case any FIR is registered against petitioner No.1, it will be open for the police authorities to take action, in accordance with law.
