MAIN CASE

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0043 dated 27.04.2019, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is the outcome of a monetary dispute between the petitioner and the complainant. He also contends that the petitioner has paid a sum of

₹1,40,000/- in full and final settlement with regard to his liability. Copy of the compromise has been placed on record in this regard.

This Court, by the order dated 17.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balvir Ram, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 17.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
